Welcome to Lake Central Food and Nutrition Services

Students may purchase meals by utilizing our pre-pay debit system. Our Department offers online payments into student accounts using a credit or debit card. Parents may deposit funds, check for low balances and view student purchases simply by creating an account. Deposits require a 4.9% transaction fee. More information is available by following the MealTime link provided on the District's webpage at www.lcsc.us. If depositing by check, please make checks payable to your child's school, and be sure to include your driver's license number as well as your child's full name and ID number on each check or envelope containing cash. Account balances are carried forward each year and do transfer between buildings.

Meal and Textbook Assistance

Lake Central School Corporation is pleased to provide free and reduced price meals to all students who qualify. It is easy to do and we accept applications throughout the school

year. Any students from families whose gross income falls within the established federal guidelines are eligible for meal and/or textbook assistance. Forms and complete instructions will be available online at the district website or in school offices beginning August 2nd. Please read the instructions carefully and fill out the form completely to avoid delays in processing. If any necessary information is missing, Food Service will mail the form home for correction. You will only need to complete one application per household, regardless of the number of children in the family, or their attendance at different schools within Lake Central.

Completed applications may be returned to the school office in an envelope marked "Food Service" or by mail to: Lake Central Food Service, 225 W. 77th Avenue, Schererville, IN 46375. Food Service will notify you of your approval or denial for meal/textbook assistance by mail within 10 business days of receipt of your completed application; please plan on sending a lunch or money with your student until you receive a letter from our office. Food Service will update the student's MealTime account to reflect the new lunch status; you do not need to notify the school kitchen. You will be responsible for any charges for meals (breakfast and/or lunch) prior to approval. You may call our office at 865-4416 between 7:00 am and 2:30 pm if you need assistance completing the application; ask for Gladys or Linda.

Online Registration

Parents must register online at www.lcsc.us. You will need your parent access code which must be activated. Students registered for kindergarten and those new to the corporation will receive their code in the mail at the end of July.

Online registration opens August 2nd. Parents who need assistance completing their online registration may go to the Lake Central High School, Computer Lab E210, on August 2nd and 3rd from 8:00 am—4:00 pm and August 8th from 11:00 am—7:00 pm.
