

MEDICATION GUIDELINES

When possible, give your child's medicine at home. Indiana Law 287 requires that schools observe certain regulations when administering medication to students. The following procedures must be followed and renewed each year. Complete Lake Central medication policy is found in the Student Handbook.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS:

1. No prescription medication shall be given or dispensed unless a medication authorization form is signed and the medication is in the original container bearing the current pharmacy label and the child's name.
2. Written permission from the child's parent or guardian must also be on file at the school.

NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS:

Over-the-counter medication requires written permission from the parent or guardian, stating the amount of medication and the hours for administration. It must be brought in the original container labeled with the student's name.
