5:00 p.m. — 6:00 p.m. **PROJECT SET-UP** ...in the Lake Central High School Cafeteria. (*Projects will be accepted until 6:00 p.m.*)

SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2013

8:45 a.m. **ARRIVAL** ...students arrive for judging. Parents are not allowed in the fair and are requested to return home.

9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. **JUDGING** ...**ONLY** participants, judges, and Science Fair personnel will be permitted in the cafeteria.

11:00 a.m. - 12:00 NOON **LUNCH** ...(*pizza and drink*) will be served to the participants after they have been judged **twice**.

12:00 NOON - 1:00 p.m. **PUBLIC EXHIBITION** ...All are invited to attend. Students are to stay with their projects to explain them to visitors.

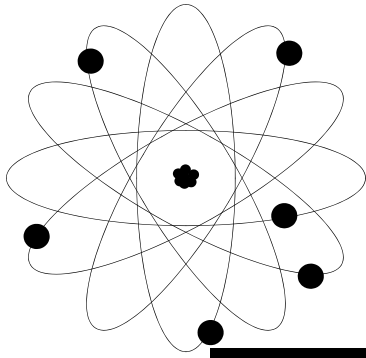

Lake Central Science Fair

FRIDAY — FEBRUARY 1, 2013

SET-UP PROJECTS in the Lake Central High School Cafeteria
from 5:00 - 6:00 p.m.

1. All projects must stand up by themselves. **DO NOT** ask for tape or tacks.
2. Remove all boxes and sacks.
3. If you need an extension cord, you must **BRING YOUR OWN!**

SATURDAY — FEBRUARY 2, 2013

ALL students must be beside their projects no later than 8:45 a.m.
Enter through the front door of the high school and go to the cafeteria.
Parents are allowed in the fair **AFTER** 12:00.

1. **Only participants are allowed** in the fair during judging. Siblings and friends are not allowed.
2. Look presentable by dressing appropriately.
3. **NO** gum, food, or drinks will be allowed in the FAIR section of the cafeteria.
4. Be courteous during judging. Offer the judges your seat.
5. There will be **NO ROAMING AROUND** while waiting to be judged or after judging.
6. If you choose to bring personal electronic devices to the science fair, they are the participant's responsibility. The Science Fair Committee is not responsible for any damage or loss that may occur. You are encouraged to bring a book with you to the fair.
7. After you have been judged, you are to remain at your seat until directed to go to the **LUNCH AREA** where you will be served pizza and a drink. Tickets will be provided after you have been judged twice. You **MUST** have a ticket.
8. All students who have projects are to be by their projects to answer questions from visitors between 12:00 NOON and 1:00 p.m.
9. Visitors may view the **FAIR** between 12:00 NOON and 1:00 p.m.
10. Awards will be presented at 1:00 p.m.
11. All projects are to be taken down by 1:30 p.m., and taken home on Saturday, February 2, 2013.
11. Every participant will receive a certificate.
