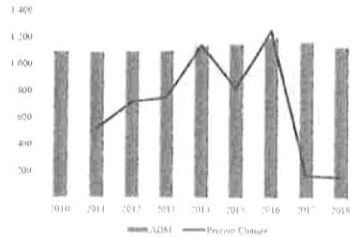

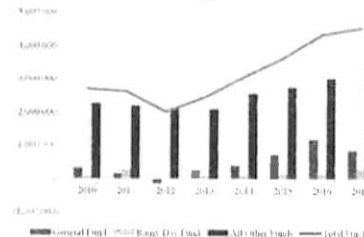

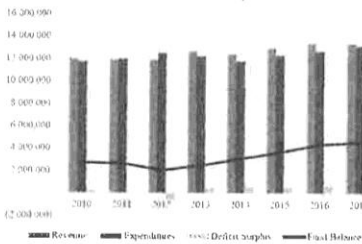

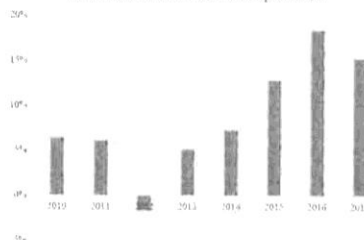

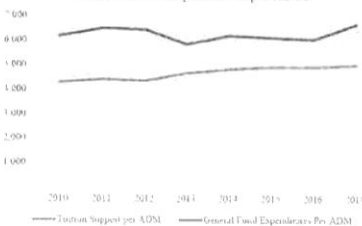

Tuition Support per ADM as compared to General Fund Expenditures per ADM



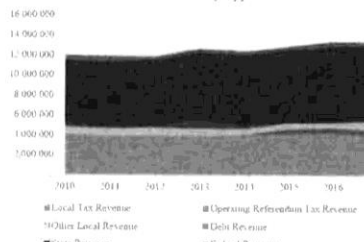
Tuition Support per ADM as compared to General Fund Expenditures per ADM

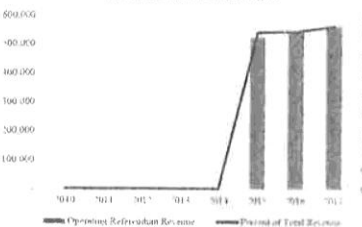
