  - 3. Awards and honors that are rare and bring credit to the Lake Central School Corporation.
- B. Honors and awards from activities NOT directly sponsored by the lake Central School Corporation which are rare and bring credit to the school corporation.
- For group or team recognition, a certificate will be made out to the Team/Group (more than 12 members) and will be accepted by the captain or designee. Individual team members will receive their certificates at a later date to be determined by the coach or mentor. If the team has fewer than 12 members, certificates are issued to individual team members at the Board meetings.
- The office will mail letters to the students and their parents, inviting them to attend a particular Board Meeting to receive their certificates (usually one week prior to the Board Meeting). Copies of the letters will be sent to the principal and sponsor/coach.
- It is the responsibility of the school principal, coach, or mentor to submit, to the corporation office, the correct names and addresses of the students to be recognized.
- Please take pictures during meets/events so the entire team is present. Pictures should be sent to Jeanne Nowacki and Matt Toczek.

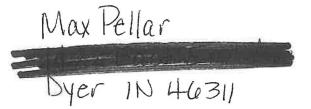

#### Instructional Delivery Model 2021-2022

- Recently, the media as well as regional Superintendents have begun to inquire about how we will instruct students during the 2021-22 school year
- Some might think this is way too early to begin this discussion however the manner in which we conduct business moving forward cannot wait long
- The ability to build schedules for teachers requires time as we all know and we believe we will need to know our plan by the end of this school year
- There is a strong desire to get everyone back in person as many families have praised the LCSC model that has kept students in school for most of the current school year
- Current trend data is positive as it suggests a significantly lower amount of infection in our community (1.0 yellow as of this writing on 2.25.21)
- What will factor into a decision?
  - The trend in data regarding positive case counts (including mutations/variants)
  - o The ability to have vaccines for everyone who desires to be vaccinated
- While our teachers have delivered significantly more challenging and engaging online lessons, a majority of our staff strongly believes in-person instruction is superior
- LCSC will investigate outsourcing an online option if we are back to an in-person only format and some families wish to remain learning on a remote platform
- We do feel that we can provide quality online lessons for a limited number of weather related cancellations in the future in order to maintain a school calendar that families can reliably schedule their vacations around
