The buildings are looking nice, I love always walking in and seeing those waxed floors. I hope you're taking some time to rest, all of you, because I know it's been a brutal couple of years, and I'm looking forward to it being a real smooth sailing year. It's going to be good. Wait, we had our athletic director, or Mr. Hall, didn't he receive an award? Mr. Hall, didn't he receive a recognition by the state association for his work?

- Howard Marshall: I think I saw something too, although I can't speak directly to it.

Quarterly Financial Report

Since we have finished the latest quarter (and end of our fiscal year), I will be giving the School Board an update on our financial position.

Transfer of Textbook Rental Fees (Action Required)

A student's textbook rental charge is divided into two components: course fees (i.e. textbooks, consumables, course fees), and general fees. When a student makes a payment, the entire amount is receipted into our Textbook Rental Fund. However, only the purchases of textbooks and consumables are allowed to be charged to the Textbook Rental Fund. The expenditures related to the general fees portion are charged to the Education Fund. From January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022, \$89,361.78 of fees were collected. Therefore, I am requesting a transfer of \$89,361.78 from the Textbook Rental Fund to the Education Fund.

Approval of 2022-2023 Course Fees (Action Required)

Course fees and general student fees for all three developmental levels for the 2022-2023 have been presented in the board packet for your approval. We ask that you please contact Sarah, Yolanda, or I prior to the board meeting if you have any questions about a specific fee, so we can conduct the proper research to answer your question.

Approval of Meal Charging Policy (Action Required)

The National School Lunch Program requires school food authorities to establish written administrative guidelines for meal charges. The highlighted portions of the document in the Board packet outline the updates to our existing policy. We seek your approval to approve the Meal Charging Policy as presented.

Approval of 2022-2023 Meal Prices (Action Required)

In order to receive financial assistance through the Child Nutrition Grant, each school district is annually required to complete the Paid Lunch Equity calculation to make sure that we are charging a high enough rate for full pay breakfast and lunch meals. Periodically, the calculation determines that we need to increase our prices. Based on this year's calculation, we need to increase our prices for full pay breakfast and lunch from the amounts charged during the 2020-2021 school year. The new rates are included in your Board packet. If you recall, because of Federal funding, all students, regardless of income, were eligible for free breakfast and lunch meals during the 2021-2022 school year. Unfortunately, that legislation expires this summer.

MEAL CHARGE GUIDELINES:

The National School Lunch Program (NSLP) requires school food authorities to establish written administrative guidelines for meal charges. Lake Central School Corporation will adhere to the following meal charge guidelines:

1. All cafeteria purchases are encouraged to be prepaid before meal service. The following options are available:
Online Payment
Parent/guardian may prepay student lunch accounts online 24 hours a day, 7 days a week with the Skyward payment feature. Click on the Skyward icon link located on the front page of the district website.
Parent/guardian may view their student's account balance online as well.
Check Payment
Parent/guardian may send a check with their student. On the check, please mark clearly your student's first and last name, their ID #, and your driver's license number. Deposit boxes are located in the Elementary, Middle School, and High School main offices.
Cash Payment
We ask you refrain from sending cash if possible, but parent/guardian may send cash with their student in an envelope clearly marked with their student's first and last name, ID #, grade, and dollar amount. Deposit boxes are located in the Elementary, Middle School, and High School main offices. High School students may also make a deposit in the North Cafeteria, at the designated area, during breakfast only.
2. Charging is allowed for one reimbursable meal at breakfast and lunch. A la carte items may not be charged. Individual milk purchases are considered an a la carte purchase and may not be charged. The parent/guardian of the student is responsible for all debt incurred by the student. Lake Central School Corporation staff are not allowed to charge.
3. If a student repeatedly comes to school with no lunch and no money, the manager will report this to the Building Administrator. It could be a sign of abuse or neglect and the proper authorities will be contacted.
4. The Food Service Director and the Business Office will coordinate communications with the parent/guardian to resolve the matter of unpaid charges.
5. An automated email and/or call system will notify parents on Sunday, Tuesday and Thursday of any outstanding negative balance.
6. All accounts must be settled at the end of the current school year. Negative notices will be emailed after the last day of school to the parent/guardian. Negative balances of \$50.00 or more may be sent to collections. The District may take action to collect unpaid funds by means of collection agencies, small claims court, or any other legal method deemed necessary by the District. Under the National School Lunch Program, the Food Service Program is not allowed to write-off debt.
7. Parents/guardians who have students graduate or withdraw from the district and have more than \$10 left in the Food Service account will be notified by the Food Service Department. Families with a positive balance will be given the option to transfer the funds to another student or to receive a refund. Before any funds are returned, money will be applied to other outstanding fees owed to Central Office.
