Acceptable reasons include: Illness (parent verified) Verified medical visit (note must be returned within 1 week or absence will be unexcused) Students should have ZERO unexcused absences An unexcused absence is any absence that is not classified as exempt, excused, or is not verified within 24 hours of an absence (i.e.the school was not notified in time). If a student accumulates 5 unexcused absences within a 9 week grading period, an attendance meeting will be held, as required by law. A student who misses 10% or more of the school year for any reason (18 days) is considered <u>chronically absent</u> by the state of Indiana. After 18 total absences, all absences beyond that will be marked as unexcused.
