- The 4x800 team of Newton, Brennan, Pettit, and Henry, dominated the field, winning in 9:38
- The 4x400 team of Henry, Sciarrabba, Brennan, and Henry won with a 4:02
- Ace Henry in the 800 with a 2:17 (#3 all-time for Kahler) with Aiden Brennan 5th in 2:23
- Billy Henry won the 400 with a :56.16 (#2 all-time for Kahler) with Karson Colin 3rd in :58
- Karson Colin was runner-up in the hurdles with a :17.6 with Austin Boudi 10th in :18.8
- Charlie Newton 3rd in the mile in 5:10 (fastest Kahler mile in 25 years) with Drew McGrath 7th in 5:39
- The 100 had Caleb Bracey 3rd in :12.3 with Kyler Wlers 13th in :13.8
- The 200 had Caleb Bracey 3rd in :25.4 and Niko Sciarrabba 7th in :26.4
- The 4x100 team of Bracey, Wiers, Sciarrabba, and Henry was 3rd in a :49.9
- The High jump had Tommy Tinsley 7th in 4'10"
- The long jump had Austin Boudi 4th in 16'02" and Colin Karson 7th in 15'05"
- The shot put had Adam Steepleton 4th in 34'5" and Tommy Tinsley 5th in 34'4"
- The discus had Adam Steepleton 3rd in 108'08" and Tommy Tinsley 6th in 92'10"
