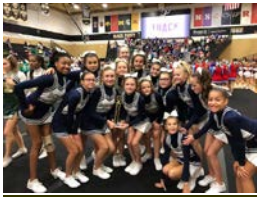


Any 7th or 8th grader interested in working the Haunted House may pick up a permission slip in the office.
