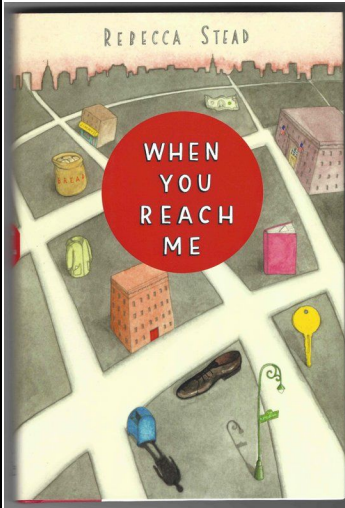

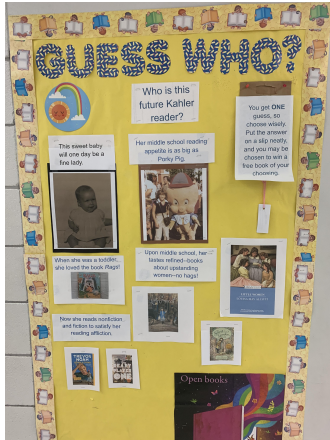


Kahler Middle School "Family Glow Run" Friday, November 4th, 6:00 PM

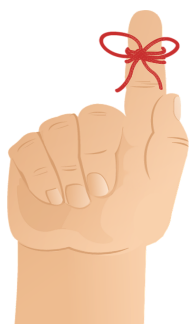
Picture Retake Day **ORDER CODE - 70701K**

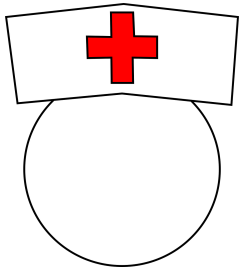
