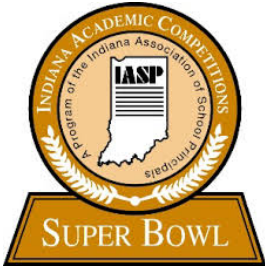

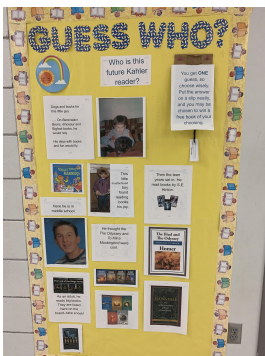


This Saturday there will be an OPEN GYM night at Midwest Training & Ice Center from 6-8pm. Cost is \$10 per child - Ages 4-18

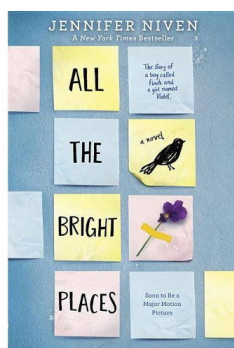

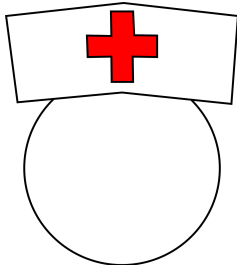
