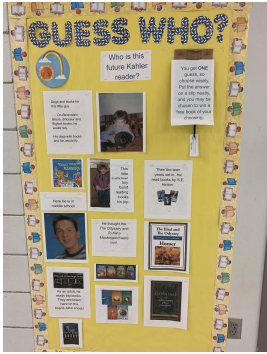

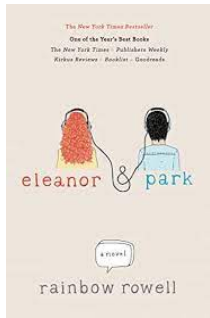


Boys track call out meeting is **Tues. Feb. 28** in the LGI during Advisory.

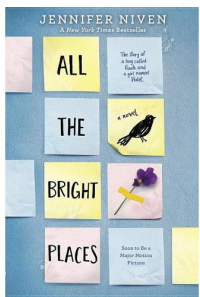

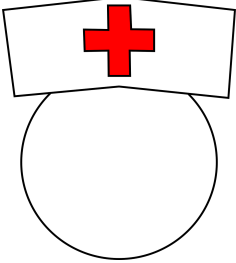
