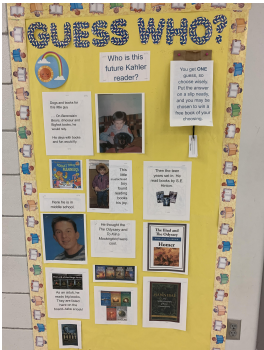

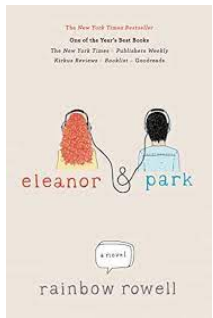
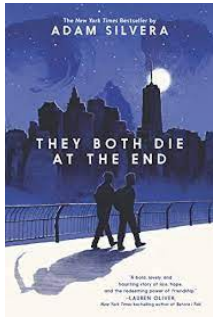


**All 5th and 6th graders** - Fitness Club is now available to 6th grade!! We have open spots - Come workout with, learn how to be healthy, and get moving!!

There is a new Guess Who Kahler Reader! Get your guess in by February 28 to win a book of your choice.



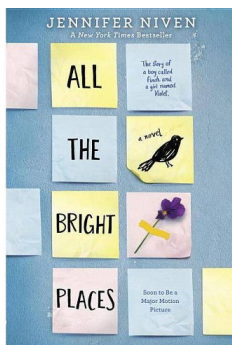

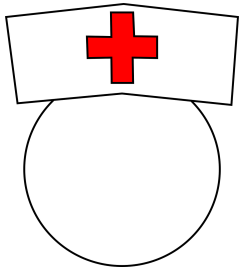
