

Flipgrids are due by Monday, February 6th to Ms. Rose in the library. If you need to record your Flipgrid here at school please come during advisory.





Book One: They Both Die at The End by Adam Silvera


Adam Silvera reminds us that there's no life without death and no love without loss in this devastating yet uplifting story about two people whose lives change over the course of one unforgettable Day.


