




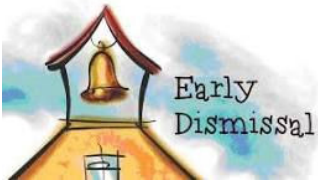
DO YOU NEED HEADPHONES?
