110 Hurdles - runners Daniel Capehart, Josh Arambula, & Blake Hambleton all under 18 seconds, Derek Szwajnos was under 20 seconds

100 meter dash - Event champ was Humzie Wadhah in 12.5 secs with Jose Serrano Acevedo in 13.2secs

1600 Run - JC Baxter, Hunter True, & Kaden Schmaal all under 6 minutes. Noey Melgoza was a mere 2 seconds from a sub 6!

400 Run - Runners Xavier Arambula, Logan Bluett, Brigham Redhead, and Blake Hambleton were all 65 seconds or faster. Josh Arambula was very close at 67 seconds.

Discus - Jack Smit was the event winner at 81 feet. Chrys Walker-Grant was second in 70 feet.

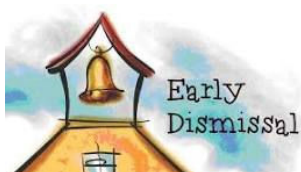
