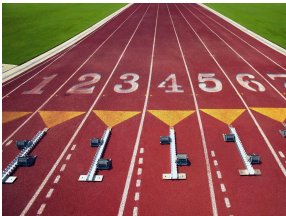

**BOYS TRACK:** A heartbreaker of a meet last night on the boys side of things. They lost a close meet last night to Grimmer. The difference was literally a matter of inches. Highlights included:

- **In the 110 hurdles,** Josh Arambula won in 17.6 with Blake Hambleton 2nd in a time of 17.69.
- **In the 100,** Homzie Wadhah was runner-up in 12.2. Runners Jose Serra Acevedo & Tzion Smothers were also sub 13 seconds.
- **In the mile, JC Baxter won in 5:21.** True, Schmal, and Julian Gomez all broke six minutes.
- **In the high jump,** Tyson St. George was runner-up in 4 feet, 4 inches.
- **In the discus,** Jack Smit was the winner in 82 feet, 9.5 inches.
- **In long jump,** it was a clean sweep for the Kolts, with Logan Bluett as the winner in a huge 16 feet, 6 inches. Tyson St. George was second at 14 feet 7.5 inches, and James Matulis 3rd at 14 feet.
- **And in the 400,** runners Logan Bluett, Xavier Arambula, and Blake Hambleton all ran 63 seconds or faster.
