Student Council is hosting a Shark Day Raffle to support Riley Children's Hospital!

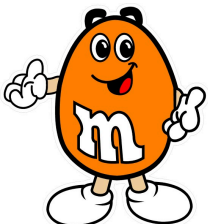
- Raffle tickets will be sold during advisory classes on Friday, April 24th

- Tyson St. George won the high jump in 4'6" with 3rd in 4:2 & Brady Baxter 4th at 4'2"
