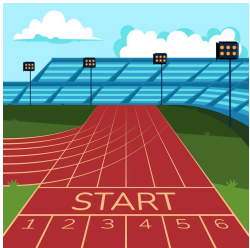

BOYS TRACK: Last night was the regular season finale for the boys' track team. The Kolts competed against Lowell. While lots of personal bests were turned in by our Kolts, the points didn't add up the way the Kolts would have liked. Nevertheless, solid job, guys.

As of this morning, coaches are still awaiting complete results and scores. But once in, full results will be pushed out via FINAL FORMS. Highlights from those include:

- 110 hurdles was won by 6th grader Josh Arambula in an impressive 17.2. No Kahler 6th nor 7th grader has ever come close to Josh's time.
- Humzie Wadhah was 100 champ in 11.8 with Jose Serrano Acevedo in 12.4 and Tzion Smothers in 12.6. Wadhah was also 200 champ in 25 seconds.
- JC Baxter was the 1600 champion in 5:06. JC's time is the #2 all-time for a KMS runner.
- Hunter True and Julian Gomez also ran fantastic in the 1600 with both breaking 5:40. Noey Melgoza, Brigham Redhead, Ethan Porter, and Vince Alegria were all under six minutes with Dylan O'Brien setting a PR of 6:09.

- **Eddie Ramos was the top Kolt in the discus. He broke the 90 foot barrier with a 90 foot, 3 inch throw.**
