Please Note: Rain will cancel any event.

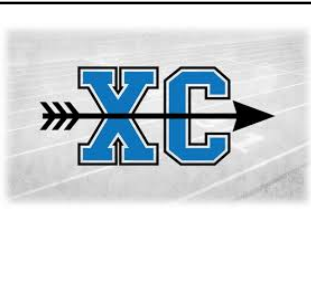
