## Kolling Parent Drop-Off/Pick-up: The First Day and Beyond

The first student day is Monday, August 17th. The school day begins at **8:10am** for in-person learning and dismissal begins **at 2:30pm**. All school days are full days.

If you choose to bring your child to school, you MUST use curbside drop-off. We anticipate a big increase in car riders this year, so it is **CRITICAL** that you help us out by staggering your arrival time as follows. This means **your vehicle cannot enter our parking lot until the assigned time**. If you have children in multiple grades, pick a time slot.

7:45 Grade 4

7:50 Grade 3

7:55 Grade 2

8:00 Grade 1

8:05 Kindergarten

We are begging you to do your best to cooperate with these staggered dropoff times. This will also help with spacing students out when they enter the building. If your vehicle stops past the flagpole, your child will enter at Door C. If your vehicle stops beyond the flagpole, your child will enter at Door B.

Even on the first day of school, parents are not permitted to park and walk their child to the sidewalk. With the number of vehicles in our parking lot, it is not safe to allow so much pedestrian traffic. **Safety First**! We will have plenty of staff to help ease every single anxious student that comes our way. We <u>ALWAYS</u> do! Also, students being dropped off will not be marked tardy until we have reached the end of the drop-off line.

If you are picking your child up from school, you must have a sign with your child's first and last name. The sign should be written dark enough and big enough for our staff to read from far. You can use the attached name form or make your own:

## All Grades Pick-up Directions:

You MUST use curb-side pick-up and wait in your vehicle for your child to be dismissed. All students that are parent pick-up will be released from classrooms for parent pick-up until 2:30. You MUST use the staggered times below to enter our parking lot. When you arrive early, you are putting your/our community at risk if we are blocking roads. Emergency vehicles cannot get through and if traffic is not flowing on Kolling road, cars try to go into oncoming traffic to go around and this is also extremely unsafe. Therefore, we will be using staggered times for pick-up as well. This means <u>your vehicle cannot enter our parking lot</u>. If you have children in multiple grades, pick a time slot.

You must enter the parking lot from the Kolling access road and enter the loading zone along the sidewalk in the front of the building. You cannot enter from US 41 for curbside pick-up. You must have a sign with your child's name showing in your windshield. Students will be loaded by staff.

All cars are to remain in park when in the unloading/loading zone and NO CAR CAN LEAVE the zone until our staff has directed you to do so. This is especially important for the first car in the line. We may still be unloading/loading vehicles behind you and if you leave, everyone will start moving when we are still loading children. The first few days of school may take longer as we get familiar with students and parents, but I am confident that pick-up will run just as quickly, smoothly, and safely as it always has.

Green arrows show the flow of traffic when coming into the lot for drop-off or pick up.

Yellow arrows show the flow of traffic when leaving the parking lot after student drop-off or pick-up.

STOP BAR

If you are the first vehicle in the line, you must stop at the STOP BAR that is painted on the parking lot. You MUST NOT move from that spot until the staff member tells you that you can. Once all vehicles in the unloading/loading zone are clear from students, the staff member will direct when the first car can move.

While in the unloading/loading zone you are not permitted to be on your cell phone. Once your car comes to a complete stop, you must put your car in park and it must remain in park until the staff members signals for cars to exit.
