Parents and students will be able to view an up-to-date calendar of practices, meetings, competitions and events.

Coaches and sponsors can send texts and emails participants and their parents letting them know if a time has changed or event has been cancelled.

Community members can join and view when school events are by subscribing to a particular sport or club.








